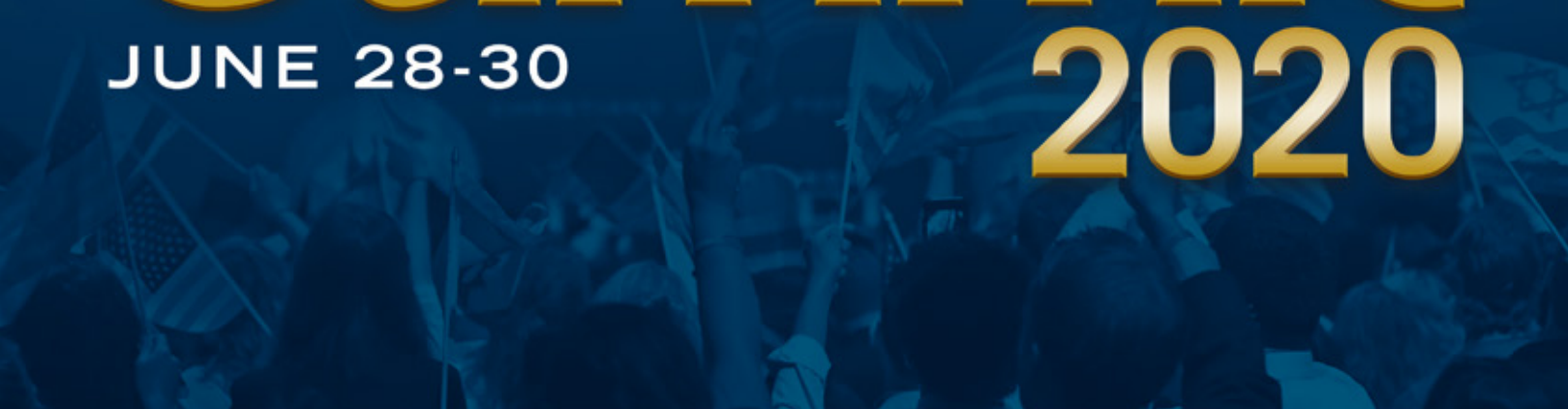

The Board of Christians United for Israel is honored to welcome you to our first-ever CUFI Virtual Summit. We are grateful that you chose to participate in the premier pro-Israel event of the year. Attending the annual CUFI Summit, whether in Washington, DC or from your home or office, is one of the most important things you can do to support Israel and the Jewish people.

As always, at the end of this year's Summit, we will take action and lobby our elected officials by delivering CUFI's 2020 Talking Points, to be presented by the Chairwoman of the Action Fund, Sandra Parker. Unlike years' past, we will make our voices heard on the Hill digitally through email and social media—however our action will be no less impactful.

CUFI is privileged to be joined by top US and Israeli officials, including: President of Israel Reuven Rivlin, Alternate Prime Minister and Minister of Defense Benjamin Gantz, Ambassador Nikki Haley, Ambassador David Friedman, Ambassador Ron Dermer, several Members of Congress, and many more special guests. There is no better time to make our united voices heard on behalf of Israel than now when the US-Israel relationship is the strongest it has ever been.

Over the past year, under the Trump Administration, our country took several vital steps to ensure the protection of Jewish students in our nation. In December 2019, one of CUFI's top Summit policy priorities was realized as President Trump issued an executive order adopting the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance's definition of anti-Semitism. This courageous and righteous move expanded upon and mirrored the Anti-Semitism Awareness Act, another top legislative priority of our 2019 Summit. CUFI's founder and Chairman, Pastor John Hagee, was privileged to be present at the historic signing of the executive order which will protect those

who are among the most vulnerable in our nation—tomorrow's leaders—our students.

Moreover, in April 2020, the House and Senate passed the Never Again Education Act, an additional CUFI legislative priority, which provides educators with federal support—via the Holocaust Memorial Museum—should they seek to teach about the Holocaust. This legislation was advanced by unanimous consent out of the Senate, largely as a result of the engagement of our Congressional Liaisons and the CUFI Action Fund's lobbyists.

Yet another testament to CUFI's critical role in defending Israel and the Jewish people was apparent at the Trump administration's unveiling of their long-awaited Middle East peace proposal in late January, where again Pastor Hagee was honored to attend.

In Missouri, a major victory was won against the Boycott, Divest and Sanctions (BDS) movement with the passage of anti-BDS legislation. Supported by over 200,000 CUFI members in the state, CUFI was integrally involved in this effort. It is because of the resolve of CUFI's members, and the Lord's unending faithfulness, that these battles have been won in strengthening the US-Israel relationship.

Since we last gathered in Washington, CUFI has grown to more than eight million committed Christian Zionists who know that standing with Israel is a biblical and moral imperative and are willing to put that faith to action. In the months ahead, by God's grace and with your faithful support, CUFI will continue to become even stronger and more impactful.

Thank you for joining the Christians United for Israel 2020 Virtual Summit and for your steadfast commitment to defend Israel and the Jewish people.

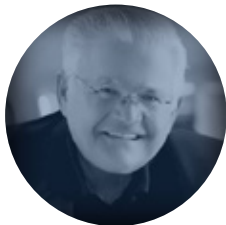

Pastor John Hagee

Pastor John Hagee is the founder and Senior Pastor of Cornerstone Church in San Antonio, Texas, a non-denominational evangelical church with more than 20,000 active members. Pastor Hagee is also founder and President of Hagee Ministries (HM), which telecasts his national radio and television teachings throughout America and around the world. In 2006, Pastor Hagee founded, and is the National Chairman of Christians United For Israel (CUFI) which has grown to become the largest pro-Israel organization in the United States with over 8 million members and one of the leading Christian grassroots movements in the world. Pastor Hagee is the author of 34 books including five New York Times best sellers.



Diana Hagee

Diana Hagee is the wife of Pastor John Hagee, founder and senior pastor of Cornerstone Church in San Antonio, Texas. Diana serves as Co-Executive Director of Christians United for Israel. Diana is the author of the best-selling book *The King's Daughter*, which was awarded the Retailers Choice Award, *The King's Daughter Workbook*, *Ruth*, the *Romance of Redemption A Love Story*, *Hannah's Song: What Love Looks Like* and *Not by Bread Alone*, as well as a book she co-authored with her husband entitled, *What Every Man Wants in a Woman—What Every Woman Wants in a Man*.

She was presented the prestigious Lion of Judah award by the Jewish Federation of Greater Houston for the long-standing work she and Pastor Hagee do on behalf of Israel and the Jewish people. Diana holds a Bachelor's Degree from Trinity University in San Antonio, Texas. She and Pastor John Hagee have five children and thirteen grandchildren.



Shari Dollinger

Shari Dollinger is the Co-Executive Director of Christians United for Israel (CUFI), is the largest pro-Israel organization in the United States, with over 8 million members. Prior to this position, Shari was CUFI's Associate Director for 11 years. Before CUFI, Shari served as the Assistant Director of The Donor Forum, as the Officer for Inter-Religious Affairs at the Embassy of Israel in Washington, DC, and a Foreign Policy Research Associate at the American Israel Public Affairs Committee (AIPAC). Shari holds a Masters in Public Administration from George Mason University and a Bachelor of Arts with a double major in Politics and Islamic/Middle Eastern Studies from Brandeis University.



Marsha Blackburn

Marsha Blackburn is the junior senator from Tennessee who sits on several key Senate committees including the Senate Armed Services and Judiciary committees. Though only recently elected to the Senate, she previously served the people of Tennessee's 7th Congressional District in the House of Representatives since 2002. Throughout her career in Washington, Blackburn has been a strong supporter of the US-Israel relationship. She was an early cosponsor of the recently passed Never Again Education Act, and has used her position to raise issues with the Administration aimed at countering anti-Israel business practices and Iranian censorship of the Iranian people.



Dr. Billye Brim

Dr. Billye Brim is CUFI's Region 5 Director and CEO of Billye Brim Ministries which includes Prayer Mountain in the Ozarks and the soon-to-be-built Migdal Arbel Prayer and Study Center in Israel. A renowned teacher on prayer, Billye has authored *The Blood and the Glory* and *The Road to Prayer Mountain*.

SPEAKERS' BIOS

Elan Carr serves as the State Department's Special Envoy for Monitoring and Combating Anti-Semitism. In his capacity, Carr is responsible for directing U.S. policies and projects aimed at countering anti-Semitism throughout the world. An officer in the US Army Reserve, he deployed to Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom, where he led an anti-terrorism team in life-saving missions throughout the country and prosecuted terrorists who attacked U.S. troops. He also assisted efforts to establish an independent Iraqi judiciary and trained Iraqi judges and lawyers on constitutional law and criminal defense. As the son of Iraqi Jewish refugees who fled persecution in Iraq, Special Envoy Carr speaks Hebrew and the Iraqi dialect of Arabic. While in Iraq, he met with remnants of the Jewish community there and led Jewish services in the former presidential palace of Saddam Hussein in Baghdad.



Elan Carr

Lt. Col. (IDF) Jonathan Conricus is the international spokesperson for the Israeli Defense Forces. Known for his articulate style and diplomatic demeanor, Conricus is one of Israel's finest warriors on one of the country's most pivotal battlegrounds: the international media. During his first post with the IDF, Conricus served in the army's elite Givatai infantry brigade. A great defender of Israel and a true friend to CUFI, he has appeared numerous times in CUFI-produced content, including on CUFI's weekly newsmagazine show, The Watchman.

Senator Tom Cotton is a United States Senator from Arkansas. Sen. Cotton's committees include the Banking Committee, the Intelligence Committee, and the Armed Services Committee, where he chairs the Air Land Power Subcommittee. He graduated from Harvard, and Harvard Law School. Sen. Cotton left his law practice after the September 11th attacks. He served nearly five years on active duty in the United States Army as an Infantry Officer. Sen. Cotton served in Iraq with the 101st Airborne and in Afghanistan with a Provincial Reconstruction Team. Between his two combat tours, Sen. Cotton served with The Old Guard at Arlington National Cemetery. During his time in the Senate he has championed the U.S-Israel relationship, actively seeking ways to strengthen strategic ties and working to counter common enemies such as the Islamic Republic of Iran.



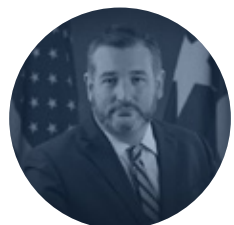

Congressman Dan Crenshaw is a freshman Member of Congress representing Texas's 2nd Congressional district. He served our country as a U.S. Navy SEAL, deploying five times overseas, where he medically retired in September of 2016 as a Lieutenant Commander after serving ten years in the SEAL Teams. Upon leaving the service, he was awarded two Bronze Stars (one with Valor), the Purple Heart, and the Navy Commendation Medal with Valor, among other citations. He currently serves on the Homeland Security and Budget Committees. A strong supporter of Israel, the Congressman frequently calls out anti-Semitism. Although only in the House of Representatives for a short period of time, Rep. Crenshaw has quickly become a leader in Congress.

Senator Ted Cruz serves on the Senate Foreign Relations, Judiciary, Commerce, and Rules Committees. He is a strong champion of the US-Israel relationship, having sponsored multiple bills to ensure Israel has the right to defend itself. He has led multiple CUFI legislative agenda items, including a bill to impose sanctions on foreign persons who use innocent civilians as human shields as well as efforts to hold the Lebanese Armed Forces accountable for cooperation with terrorist army Hezbollah. Sen. Cruz was also the lead sponsor of a bill codifying US policy recognizing Israel's sovereignty over the Golan Heights.

William Daroff

William Daroff is the CEO of the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations. He formerly served as the Senior Vice President for Public Policy and Director of the Washington office of the Jewish Federations of North America. Daroff is known in Washington and throughout the pro-Israel community for his professionalism and ability to build bridges, and he has been a long-time friend of CUFI. Daroff received a bachelor's degree in Political Science and History, Master's Degree in Political Science, and Juris Doctorate from Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, Ohio. He also studied at Kraków, Poland's Jagiellonian University, where he received a certificate in the history of Eastern European Jewry and The Holocaust.

Ambassador Danny Danon is Israel's 17th Permanent Representative to the United Nations. With over twenty years of experience representing Israel overseas and within the public sector, Ambassador Danon has developed a reputation as one of Israel's most ardent defenders. Prior to assuming his role as UN ambassador, Danon served in the 18th, 19th, and 20th Knessets. From 2013-2014, Danon served as Deputy Minister of Defense, where he headed the Social Welfare and the Reserves departments. In 2015, Danon was appointed Israel's Minister of Science and Technology. Prior to serving in the Knesset, Danon was a member of the Board of Directors of the Jewish Agency for Israel and a member of the Executive Board of the World Zionist Organization, where he led efforts to combat Antisemitism. Danon also previously served as a representative of the Jewish Agency in Miami, where he promoted Israel advocacy to the community and on campuses. Ambassador Danon has contributed to leading publications including The Wall Street Journal and The New York Times and has made regular appearances in international media outlets including CNN and Fox News.

Ron Dermer

Ambassador Ron Dermer, an American-born Israeli political consultant and diplomat, has served as the Israeli Ambassador to the United States since October 2013. During his tenure in Washington, Ambassador Dermer has worked closely with CUFI leadership to strengthen support for Israel among American Christians. He opposed the misguided Iran Nuclear Deal, which has made Israel and America less safe, and encouraged President Trump to move the US Embassy to Jerusalem. He has appeared five times at the CUFI Washington Summit on behalf of the State of Israel.



Gilad Erdan

Gilad Erdan is a member of Israel's parliament (the Knesset) and currently serves as Israel's Regional Cooperation Minister. Previously Erdan has held several ministerial positions including Minister of Strategic Affairs. Erdan, however, will soon be leaving the Knesset as he has been appointed to hold the positions of Israel's Ambassador to the United States as well as Ambassador to the United Nations. During his military service, Erdan attained the rank of Captain. He is an attorney by trade.

Ambassador David Friedman was nominated by President Trump on January 20, 2017 and sworn in as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to the State of Israel on March 29, 2017. He was the first bilateral ambassador to be confirmed in the Trump Administration. Prior to his appointment as Ambassador, Mr. Friedman was a nationally top-ranked attorney, and a founding partner of Kasowitz, Benson, Torres & Friedman of New York, New York. He frequently represented high-profile clients in large and significant cases, and has published articles and lectured on novel and complex areas of law. Ambassador Friedman has played a lead role in negotiating multilateral disputes in some of the nation's most complex business and financial restructurings. Well known for his excellent public speaking, negotiating and interpersonal skills, he has been active for decades in U.S. policy as it relates to Israel and the Middle East. He speaks and reads Hebrew and has traveled to Israel extensively.

SPEAKERS' BIOS

Benjamin Gantz serves as Israel's Alternate Prime Minister and Minister of Defense. Prior to entering electoral politics, Gantz rose to the very top of the ranks of the Israel Defense Forces (IDF), serving as the army's Chief of Staff. His military career started in Israel's elite Paratroopers Brigade where he participated in the First Lebanon War, counter-terror operations, and commanded the unit responsible for Operation Solomon, which airlifted 14,000 Ethiopian Jews home to Israel. Prior to becoming the IDF Chief of Staff, he held several senior positions and completed special forces training with the US Army, served as Israel's military attaché in Washington, and commanded the Israeli Air Force's Shaldag (Kingfisher) Unit, a commando force which specializes in reconnaissance and ground control of aircraft while in hostile territory.



Benjamin Gantz

Bonnie Glick is the Deputy Administrator of the US Agency for International Development (USAID). Glick previously served as a Foreign Service Officer with the State Department, serving tours of duty in Africa, Central America and at the United Nations.

Richard Goldberg is a senior advisor at the Foundation for Defense of Democracies (FDD). He previously spent a decade working on Capitol Hill, and later served as chief of staff for Illinois Governor Bruce Rauner. Throughout his government service, Goldberg has worked diligently in support of the US-Israel Relationship. He played a key role in U.S. funding for the Arrow-3 program, Iron Dome, and the deployment of an advanced missile defense radar to the Negev Desert, drafted and negotiated passage of legislation sanctioning Iran and promoting human rights in the Islamic Republic, and spearheaded the first-ever state legislation to divest public pension funds from companies engaged in boycotts of Israel.



Richard Goldberg

Kasim Hafeez is a British citizen of Pakistani Muslim heritage who grew up being exposed to radical Anti-Western, Anti-Semitic and Anti-Israel ideas on a daily basis. During his teenage years Kasim embraced a radical Islamist ideology and became very active in the anti-Israel movement. Thankfully Alan Dershowitz's book 'The Case for Israel' challenged Kasim's fundamental beliefs and caused him to undertake a period of research and reflection that led him to Israel in 2007. Witnessing the true nature of the Jewish state changed Kasim's perception of Israel. He felt a moral obligation to publically speak out for Israel and the dangers of radical Islam. He has spoken all over the world including the 2013 Global Forum on Combatting Anti-Semitism. Kasim has appeared on radio and television and print media.

Lynne Hammond is the National Director of Daughters for Zion, CUFI's Prayer Network. Lynne is a teacher and author on prayer. Lynne and her husband Mac pastor Living Word Christian Center and are CUFI Region 8 Directors and members of CUFI's Executive Board.

Ambassador Nikki Haley served as the US Ambassador to the United Nations for the first two years of the Trump administration, and previously served as Governor of South Carolina. During her post at the UN, she was known for her unwavering commitment to protecting America's interests in the world, and her impassioned defense of Israel. As Governor, Haley signed the country's first anti-BDS legislation into law. CUFI was privileged to welcome Ambassador Haley to speak at the 2018 Washington Summit, and we are thrilled to hear from her again this year at our Virtual Summit.

Stephen Harper

Stephen Harper served as the Prime Minister of Canada from 2006 through 2015, and has been active in Canadian politics since the 1990s. Throughout his career, Harper has shown a deep affinity for Israel and an acute understanding of the challenges faced by the Jewish state. From defending Israel's right to defend itself and condemning Hamas's use of human shields, to standing up to the United Nations for its unfair treatment of Israel, Harper can be counted as among Israel's most influential and outspoken friends on the world's stage.



Malcolm Hoenlein

Malcolm Hoenlein is the Executive Vice Chairman of the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations - the coordinating body for 50 national Jewish organizations. Previously, he served as the founding Executive Director of the Jewish Community Relations Council of Greater New York, and as the Executive Director of the Greater New York conference on Soviet Jewry. Hoenlein has traveled throughout the world meeting with and advising world leaders and Jewish communities. He has written and lectured across the U.S. and abroad on a host of issues of concern to the Jewish and pro-Israel community.



Senator James Lankford

Senator James Lankford is the junior senator from Oklahoma. Along with Sen. Jacky Rosen of Nevada, Lankford is the co-founder and co-chair of the Senate Bipartisan Task Force for Combatting Anti-Semitism. In addition to his work combating anti-Semitism, Lankford is a stalwart defender of Israel and has a keen understanding of Middle East issues. He was a leader in the fight to see Pastor Brunson released after the radical Islamist regime in Turkey arrested the pastor on trumped up charges. Likewise, Lankford has been a leader on multiple pieces of legislation holding Turkey responsible for its malevolent actions. He has also been a supporter of numerous pieces of legislation that work to strengthen the US-Israel relationship including the United States-Israel Security Assistance Authorization Act of 2020.



Mark Levin

Mark Levin is a nationally syndicated radio host, the host of Life, Liberty and Levin on the Fox News channel and editor-in-chief of the Conservative Review. Levin formerly worked in President Ronald Reagan's administration as Chief of Staff to then Attorney General Edwin Meese, and has authored seven bestselling books. Throughout all his endeavors, Levin has been a consistent and staunch defender of the US-Israel relationship and Western values.



Aryeh Lightstone

Aryeh Lightstone, formerly Regional Director of New York NCSY, was appointed in April 2017 to serve as advisor to U.S. ambassador to Israel David Friedman. A graduate of Yeshiva University who received his rabbinic ordination from the Rabbi Isaac Elchanan Theological Seminary, Rabbi Lightstone has been fully engaged in all forms of communal work. Rabbi Lightstone founded Aleph Beta Academy, the JUMP Leadership initiative, Jerusalem Ambassadors, and Friday Night Lights which are all ongoing international and successful programs. In addition to running NCSY in the New York area, Rabbi Lightstone developed the first mainstream Jewish college credit program for unaffiliated high school students from across North America.

He has also been the Chairman of the Likud Party since 1993. Prime Minister Netanyahu has also previously served as the Minister of Foreign Affairs and as Minister of Finance, as a business consultant to Israeli high-tech companies, and as Israel's ambassador to the United Nations. After serving six years in the IDF's most elite Special Forces unit, Sayeret Matkal, and rising to the rank of captain, Netanyahu studied at MIT in Boston and received a B.Sc. in architecture and an M.Sc. in Management Studies. He also studied political science at MIT and Harvard University.

Michael R. Pompeo was sworn in as Secretary of State on April 26, 2018. That month, CUFI had launched a campaign in support of Pompeo's nomination, and our members sent over 60,000 emails to Senate offices expressing their support. Pompeo previously served as Director of the Central Intelligence Agency from January 2017 to April 2018. Prior to joining the Trump Administration, he was serving in his fourth term as congressman from Kansas' 4th District where he was the lead sponsor of H.R. 4815 (114th): Iran Ballistic Missile Sanctions Act of 2016. Pompeo graduated first in his class at the United States Military Academy at West Point in 1986 and served as a cavalry officer patrolling the Iron Curtain before the fall of the Berlin Wall. He also served with the 2nd Squadron, 7th Cavalry in the US Army's Fourth Infantry Division. Throughout this time, Pompeo has been a consistent supporter of Israel's right to self-determination and security.

President Reuven Rivlin is the President of the State of Israel. During his tenure, Rivlin has emphasized outreach to Israel's Christian allies around the globe. Rivlin previously served as the Speaker of the Israel's Parliament (the Knesset) and as the Minister of Communications. One of the country's most respected elder statesmen, Rivlin was born in Jerusalem before the founding of modern Israel, and served as an intelligence officer with the Jerusalem brigade and the IDF's famed paratrooper brigade during the Six Day War. He is an attorney by trade.



Senator Jacky Rosen

Senator Jacky Rosen is the junior senator from Nevada. Since coming to the Senate, she has been a vocal leader in efforts to support for Israel and the Jewish people. Along with Sen. James Lankford of Oklahoma, Rosen is the co-founder and co-chair of the Senate Bipartisan Task Force for Combatting Anti-Semitism. She was the lead sponsor of the recently passed Never Again Education Act, the lead sponsor of legislation promoting US-Israel cyber cooperation, and was a co-sponsor of the Anti-Semitism Awareness Act.

Irving Roth, a Holocaust survivor, is the Director of the Holocaust Resource Center at Temple Judea of Manhasset, New York. He is also the former education director of the Holocaust Memorial and Education Center of Nassau County. An internationally known educator, Mr. Roth has endeavored to teach people about the Holocaust and the lessons that can be learned from that experience. Through his participation in programs such as Adopt A Survivor and the March of the Living, Mr. Roth works to ensure that an atrocity like the Holocaust never happens again. Mr. Roth has been the recipient of numerous awards and accolades for his work promoting a more accepting and diverse world. It is his life's mission to make the world a better place that has earned Mr. Roth the Spirit of Anne Frank Award.

Senator Marco Rubio is the Chairman of the Small Business and Entrepreneurship Committee and serves on the Senate Foreign Relations and Intelligence Committees. Sen. Rubio is a stalwart supporter of Israel, having sponsored multiple bills to strengthen the US-Israel relationship and protect Israel against those who seek to destroy her. Sen. Rubio has taken a leadership role in fighting the BDS movement. He is the lead sponsor of the US-Israel Security Assistance Authorization Act of 2020 (S. 3176) and was one of the original cosponsors of the recently passed Never Again Education Act.

Dr. Jonathan Schanzer is Senior Vice President for Research at the Foundation for Defense of Democracies, a leading foreign policy think-tank. He is also on the leadership team of FDD's Center on Economic and Financial Power. A sought-after public speaker, Schanzer has traveled widely throughout the Middle East and studied Middle East history in four countries. He earned his PhD from King's College London, where he wrote his dissertation on the U.S. Congress and its efforts to combat terrorism in the 20th century. Schanzer previously worked as a terrorism finance analyst at the U.S. Department of the Treasury, where he played an integral role in the designation of numerous terrorist financiers.

Rabbi Aryeh Scheinberg has been the spiritual leader of San Antonio's Congregation Rodfei Sholom for nearly 50 years and has stood beside Pastor Hagee in an effort to build between the Christian and Jewish communities since the first Night to Honor Israel more than 30 years ago. Rabbi Scheinberg is the Chair of the Rabbinical Advisory Board and also acts as advisor to Pastor Hagee and Hagee Ministry's annual charitable donations. He was the recipient of the 2003 National Conference of Christians & Jews (NCCJ) "Brotherhood-Sisterhood Humanitarian Award" and also the 2003 United Jewish Communities "Rabbinical Award." He has been honored as "Man of The Year" by the State of Israel Bonds. In 2018, the Foreign Ministry of Israel together with the Center for Jewish-Christian Understanding bestowed upon Rabbi Scheinberg with a special award for his pioneering work in Jewish-Christian relations.

Senator Tim Scott has served South Carolina in the U.S. Senate since 2013. Prior to public service, Scott built a successful small business. He was first elected to Charleston County Council, then to the South Carolina State House, and then to the U.S. House of Representatives. He was the lead sponsor of the Anti-Semitism Awareness Act of 2019 (S.852) which was the basis for President Trump's Executive Order on combating Anti-Semitism last December. Senator Scott is a stalwart supporter of the US-Israel relationship and was also a cosponsor of the recently enacted Never Again Education Act.

Natan Sharansky is the Chairman of the Institute for the Study of Global Anti-Semitism and Policy, and the former Chairman of the Executive of the Jewish Agency for Israel. Sharansky has devoted his life to serving his people and the state of Israel. A mathematician by trade, Sharansky grew up in the Soviet Union and became a dissident. He eventually was arrested and was imprisoned for nine years by the Soviets. Upon his release, Sharansky immigrated to Israel. A hero to the Jewish people, Sharansky soon entered the Israeli parliament, holding several ministerial posts throughout his political career, including Deputy Prime Minister. He has authored two books, including *The Case for Democracy: The Power of Freedom to Overcome Tyranny and Terror*, which was written with Ron Dermer, Israel's current Ambassador to the United States.

Dr. Kenneth W. Stein is Professor of Contemporary Middle Eastern History and Political Science, as well as the Founding Director of the Institute for the Study of Modern Israel at Emory University and the Founding President of the Center for Israel Education (CIE) in Atlanta. He has taught at Emory since 1977 and in 2006 was a Visiting Professor of Political Science at Brown University. His scholarship focuses on the origins and development of modern Israel, the Arab-Israeli conflict, and US relations with Israel and the Arab world. Two of his works remain standards in their fields, *The Land Question in Palestine, 1917-1939* (1984) and *Heroic Diplomacy: Sadat, Kissinger, Carter, Begin and the Quest for Arab-Israeli Peace* (1999). During the last decade, he has led dozens of Israel enrichment workshops and seminars reaching more than 2200 pre-collegiate Jewish teachers and rabbis, reaching some 360,000 students in North and South America. He completed advanced graduate work at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem and earned his graduate degrees at the University of Michigan.

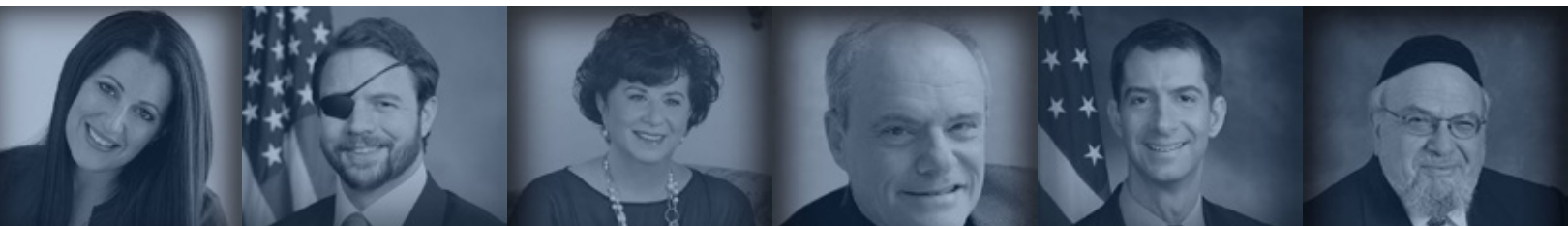

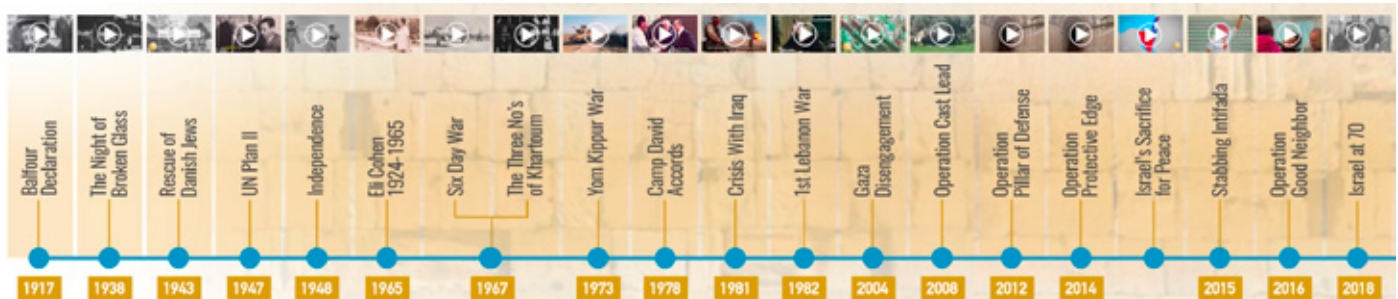

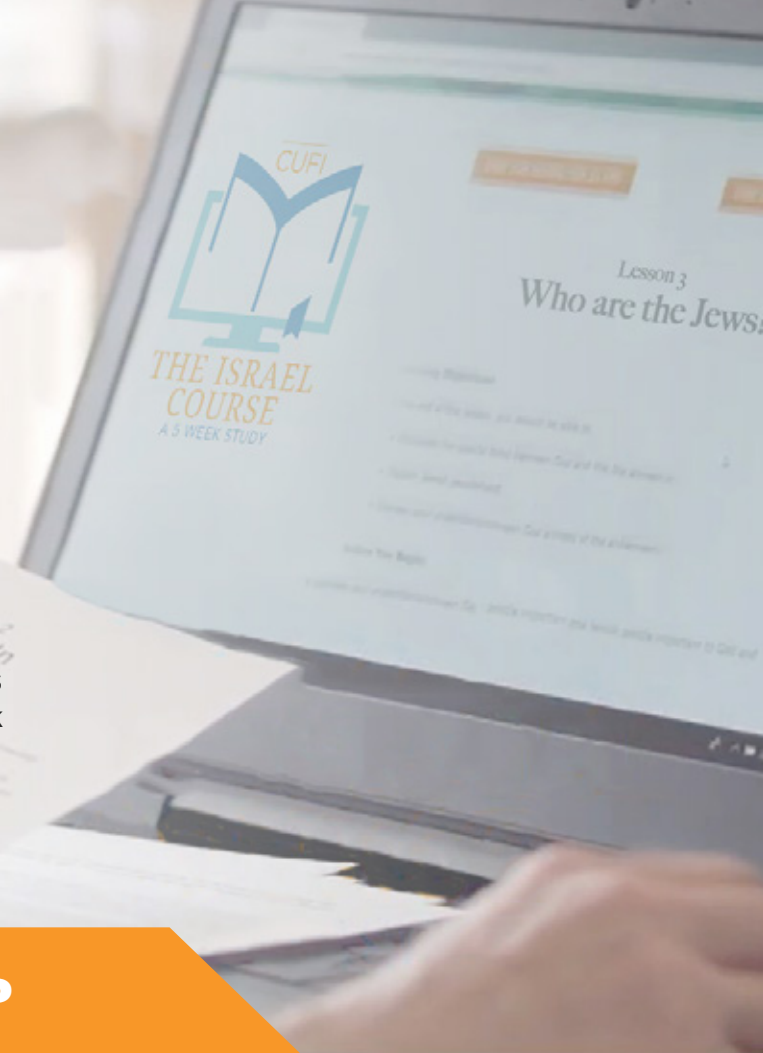
