

The entire Bibas family, was kidnapped by Hamas from their home in Kibbutz Nir Oz on October 7, 2023, during the terrorists' assault on Israel. While Shiri and their sons, 9-month-old Kfir and 4-year-old Ariel, were torn away to Gaza, Yarden was separated and held hostage for 484 days in brutal conditions, including underground cages, where Hamas tormented him with twisted propaganda about his loved ones.

Yarden was released on February 1, 2025, under a ceasefire and hostage exchange. He endured unimaginable horrors, including being forced by Hamas in November 2023 to record a video claiming Israeli strikes killed his wife and sons.

The IDF confirmed through intelligence and forensic evidence from the identification process that the two children were brutally murdered in captivity by Hamas in November 2023, just a month after their abduction, and were not killed by an IAF strike, as Hamas originally claimed.

On February 19, 2025, their bodies were returned to Israel along with hostage Oded Lifshitz. Shiri's body was returned two days later, after Hamas's depraved attempt to pass off an unidentified body as hers, sending another woman's body in a locked coffin with keys that did not match, according to extensive testing by the L. Greenberg Institute of Forensic Medicine at Abu Kabir.

Yarden urged the IDF spokesperson to ensure the world knows the barbaric reality of his family's murder, a call to unmask Hamas's evil.

May Shiri's, Ariel's, and Kfir's memories forever be a blessing.
